SUNDAY MARKET FESTIVAL VENDOR RULES + APPLICATION

MISSION:

The mission of the Sunday Market Festival is to cultivate and promote the local production of agricultural and specialty products through an opportunity for producers, farmers, and artisans. We strive to provide a vibrant, successful market to create a bridge between the local agricultural community and consumers.

1. VENDORS

- 1. The Sunday Monthly Market Festival is open to vendors who sell their own "yield". Brokered products are to be held to a maximum of 50% of the vendor's inventory offered for sale on a weekly basis. Brokered items must be labeled with the name and location of the grower or farm of origin. If the quantity is unable to be labeled individually, then an 8.5"x11" minimum sign shall be placed near the items in plain view.
- 2. Vendors must openly display their business name and location at their designated vending booth. Signs must be a minimum of $11'' \times 17''$ in size and displayed in plain view to patrons to visualize.

2. PRODUCTS

- Vendor compliance with all Federal, State and Local regulations is mandatory and implied. Vendors of regulated products are obligated to know, understand, and comply with the regulations which govern their product.
- 2. Agricultural items allowed for sale include but are not limited to: fruits, vegetables, grains, herbs, flowers, potted and bedding plants.
- 3. Processed items allowed for sale include but are not limited to: jams, jellies, sauces, cooking oils, baked goods, and fruit juices. No sale of alcoholic beverages is allowed.
- 4. Animal goods include, but are not limited to: meats, cheeses, eggs, honey, fibers, and other products derived from animal by-products.
- 5. Arts and crafts items may be sold. An Artisan vendor is one who uses creative skills in manufacturing, writing, or arranging materials resulting in a finished product. Items must be handcrafted on an individual basis by the Artisan and must not be a modified commercially purchased item. After approval of items, no new items may be added after the application deadline.

3. VENDOR/ARTISAN DESIGNATION

- 1. Each vendor space will be approximately 10'x10'. Additional spaces may be provided upon contribution. All spaces must be reserved at the time of application.
- 2. Primary sales of goods must be from a table or display provided by the vendor. Your vehicle may be used to store excess goods. However, no sale from the tailgate of a vehicle is permitted.
- 3. Canopies may be used, but must be weighted or staked into the ground for safety procedures. Canopies must fit within vendor space, approximately 10'x10'.

4. Vendors are responsible for the policing and cleanliness of their space and for the overall cleanliness of the market location during and immediately after the market. Violation may be grounds for denial of future vending opportunities.

4. MARKET HOURS

- 1. Vendors are expected to be set up at the market no later than 10am and stay for the duration of the market, until 4pm, unless otherwise noted to the market hosts.
- 2. If any vendor becomes sick, uncomfortable with the weather, had a family emergency, etc. they may leave upon informing the market host.

5. MARKET BEHAVIOR

- 1. Vendors are independent entrepreneurs with a common stake in creating a vibrant marketplace. Inappropriate language or behavior, including profanity, harassment, or abuse by a vendor or participant, toward anyone, shall be grounds for removal from the
- 2. Vendors must not smoke in designated market grounds.

6. RULE ENFORCEMENT

1. Market rules are established by Flavor Fruit Farm, LLC. and are subject to change. Vendors that do not comply with the rules after warning will be denied vending privileges. Market rules established March 2023.

7. VENDOR CONTRIBUTION

- 1. January March: Indoor vendor contribution is \$50 per space. Outdoor vendor contribution is \$25 per space.
- 2. April August: All vendor spaces outdoors. \$25 per 10x10 vendor space.
- 3. Payment is due for markets at the date of event BEFORE SETUP. This may be paid by cash

or check payable to Meckley's Flavor Fruit Farm.
